Unipres Corporation (Head Office: Yokohama-City, Kanagawa-Pref, President: Satoru Nito) passed a resolution at a meeting of its Board of Directors on July 20, 2009, to establish a local subsidiary to develop operations related to metal stamped automobile body parts in the Kingdom of Thailand. The details are as follows.

1. Profile of subsidiary

2. Reason for establishment of subsidiary

Unipres received an order for metal stamped automobile body parts for Nissan Motor Co., Ltd.'s global entry car which is to be produced by Nissan Motor (Thailand) Co., Ltd., a Nissan subsidiary. With this, Unipres has decided to launch operations in the Kingdom of Thailand and will set up a subsidiary there to sell metal stamped automobile body parts.

In regard to the production work in the Kingdom of Thailand, Unipres will provide technical assistance to Company KYOKUYO INDUSTRIAL (THAILAND) CO., LTD (Representative: Hideaki Mori, Address: Chonburi, Kingdom of Thailand) , which is a subsidiary of KYOKUYO INDUSTRIAL CO., LTD., (Office: Nagaizumi-cho, Suntou-gun, Shizuoka-Pref, President: Masashi Sano) as well to Companies THAI SUMMIT AUTOPARTS INDUSTRY CO., LTD.
